

## HYDRANT METER APPLICATION INFORMATION SHEET

Effective January 1, Town of Gilbert Ordinance #1437 states “NO POTABLE WATER FROM FIRE HYDRANTS SHALL BE USED ON PARCELS OR LOTS OF TEN ACRES OR MORE IN SIZE FOR CONSTRUCTION PURPOSES.”

Hydrant meters shall be used for construction water ONLY on parcels or lots measuring less than 10 acres in size.

The following information must be submitted with the application:

- 8 ½” x 11” Site Plan Map

**Applications received without the map will not be accepted.**

The meter is approved for use on this project only and cannot be transferred to another project. You must apply for a new hydrant meter for each project.

### **Developments that DO NOT meet the less than 10 acres requirement:**

All of the developable lands within Gilbert’s planning area are located within an irrigation district which allows the use of non-potable water for construction purposes. Determine which irrigation district the development is located in and call the district to arrange for construction water.

### Waiver Exemption:

According to Ordinance #1437, a waiver exempting the development from the hydrant meter limitation can be applied for by:

- Submitting a copy of the original application showing denied
- 8 ½” x 11” Site Plan Map identifying the locations of irrigation facilities within 1 mile of the site boundaries
- A letter explaining why it is not feasible to use non-potable water on the development
