

OPEN HOUSE MEETING NOTES
“ARTS, CULTURE, ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT”
JUNE 17, 2013

- Meeting began AT 5:05pm.

Summary Comments:

- The majority of attendees offered positive comments regarding the district.
- Like the fact that TOG is taking an interest in downtown and that establishing the district will provide more flexibility in developing the area.
- Two church representatives attending are supportive.
- Very receptive to the Town effort to create a district.
- Questions asked regarding status of prior development projects they had heard about.
- Not supportive. Believes it will have a negative impact on schools.
- Feel this will attract a plethora of bars.
- Support that it might encourage more intense uses.
- Believe that the 300' separation is not necessary or needed.
- Most were excited that Town was being proactive at looking to attract future development.
- Asked if the Map will change.
- People excited about what projects might be coming to the Heritage District.
- Some questioned why there are not more arts and cultural establishments in downtown.
