

2017-2018 CODE OF CONDUCT

McQueen Park Activity Center



PURPOSE:

The Town of Gilbert Parks and Recreation Department is dedicated to promote a healthy, positive recreation environment to ensure the safety and enjoyment of its participants.

INTRODUCTION & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Children ages 12 and older may attend the McQueen Park Activity Center unattended. Children under the age of 12 not participating in a registration based program, event or class must be accompanied and supervised by an adult age 18 years of age or older at all times. Children under 12 who do not have adult supervision and would like to attend the center can register in one of our Town of Gilbert recreational programs. We have many to choose from including sports, dance, gymnastics, arts & crafts, cooking, etc. For more information about these and many more class opportunities, go to gilbertaz.gov/recguide or GilbertRecreation.com.

Facility participants may use the gymnasium for a daily admission fee. See gym schedule for times and pricing. Loitering in the lobby, hallways and patio areas is not permitted.

Please read through the following information with your child, sign, date and return to a McQueen Park Activity Center employee. If you're a Gilbert resident, verification of residency is required. A Town of Gilbert employee will verify contact information through our Utilities Department.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

All persons in the facility are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is courteous and respectful of other guests, staff, the facility and equipment. Compromising your safety or the safety of others, verbal or physical threats, aggressive behavior or fighting will result in immediate suspension of all parties.

The town observes the following as unacceptable behavior; including, but not limited to:

- Lewd, obscene or indecent conduct or expression; including but not limited to rudeness, profanity, harassment, discrimination, argumentative behavior, verbal abuse and/or intimidation.
- Threatening or jeopardizing the health, safety and/or well being of others.
- Destruction, damage or theft to a Town of Gilbert facility or property.
- Smoking in any indoor facility or within 25 feet of the facility.
- Alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs consumed prior to or while using the facility.

CONSEQUENCES FOR MISCONDUCT:

The code of conduct will be enforced by all Town of Gilbert employees whose authority shall prevail in all cases. The following program of corrective action will be in effect for offenders resulting in all or some of the following actions including, but not limited to:

- A verbal warning and review of the **CODE OR CONDUCT**.
- A suspension from the use of all Gilbert Parks and Recreation facilities (indoors) and the Skate Park (outdoors) for a period of time and the issuance of a Notice of Violation.
- Failure to comply with Town of Gilbert rules and regulations may result in a police trespass.

The circumstances and severity of the incident as determined by the Recreation Coordinator and Recreation Supervisor will determine the length of suspension.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK & RELEASE OF CLAIMS & NOTICE

All participants and parent/guardian must sign the hold harmless waiver form below acknowledging they have read and agreed with the code of conduct, posted rules and acknowledged the consequences should they not be complied with.

I allow my child and/or myself to participate in this program. We release the Town of Gilbert and its employees of any liability, claims or demands, which we may hereafter have as a result of participating in recreational activities, using recreational facilities, or being transported to events as part of this program. I understand that the Town of Gilbert has no medical insurance for this program. I understand that there are risks involved with strenuous physical exertion as part of this program, including serious injury. I am at least 18 years of age. I also give my permission of any photographs, audio or video recordings taken of my child and/or myself to be used by the Town of Gilbert for any lawful purpose, including the promotion of Town events on the Town’s website for the Town’s social media sites. I verify that all information provided is correct, and agree that the Town of Gilbert may require proof. I understand that providing incorrect information including but not limited to participant date of birth and address is grounds for removal from the program and may result in suspension of the privilege to participate in future programs.
